Yet when Smith slowed on the track and pulled into the pits Bucklen was now all alone out front. #39 Jack Nugent eventually caught Bucklen and began to work him on the low side but Darren was hooked up in the high groove and held off Nugent, #12 Bruce Yackey, #6 Dominic Urestta, and #11 Darren Robertson. By winning segment 1 Bucklen would start on the pole for the final 50 lap segment.
